Using Cxbladder – three simple steps

1. Collection:

Submit a urine sample from your Doctor's clinic*. Cxbladder's sampling system is quick, easy-to-use, and painless. An express courier service will transport your sample to our laboratory.

2. Testing:

Your sample will be analyzed in our CLIA certified and ISO 15189 accredited laboratory.



3. Results:

A test report with actionable results will be sent to your Doctor within 5 working days of our laboratory team confirming they've received your sample.
